I AM MALALA

Malala was born in Mingora, Pakistan, on July 12th, 1997. Welcoming a baby girl is not always cause for celebration in Pakistan but her father, Ziauddin, as educator, promised that Malala would go to school and be treated with equality in his home.

In 2007, Taliban militants took control of Mingora. Eventually they prohibited girls from going to school. In 2009, using the pen name "Gul Makai" to protect her identity, Malala started blogging for the BBC about life under the Taliban.

Malala became very popular, both in Pakistan and around the world, as she continued speaking out about the right of all women to an education. As a result, the Taliban considered her a threat and a target. In October 2012 a masked gunman boarded Malala's school bus and shot her in the head, neck and shoulder. She was 15 years old at the time. Malala survived, but remained in critical condition. She was taken to a hospital in The United Kingdom. After multiple surgeries and months of rehabilitation, she was able to attend school in Birmingham in March 2013.

In her first public appearance since the attack, Malala spoke at the United Nations on her 16th birthday. The U.N. declared July 12th "Malala Day". She also published her first book *I Am Malala*, her autobiography. It became an international bestseller. Determined to continue her campaign for girls' education, she founded "The Malala Fund", an organization dedicated to give all girls access to education.

In 2014, at the age of 17, Malala Yousafzai became the youngest person to receive the Nobel Peace Prize. She is currently attending the University of Oxford, where she is studying philosophy, politics and economics. She balances her school work and social life with leading the fight for girls' education around the world.
