- ❖ SIN ANTECEDENTE "I don't know **what** to do"
- ❖ CON ANTECEDENTE
  - NON-DEFINING "My uncle, **who** is a doctor, lives in Madrid"
    - No that
    - No omisión de relativo
    - Entre comas
  - DEFINING "My uncle **who** is a doctor lives in Madrid"
    - Puede aparecer *that*
    - No comas
    - Omisión de relativo cuando va seguido de sujeto:

"The man **who** visited us yesterday is a teacher"

"The man (**that**) I met at the bus stop told me truth"

PRONOMBRES RELATIVOS	
<b>WHO</b> : antecedente personas	"This is the boy <b>who</b> you were asking me <b>about</b> "
<b>WHOM</b> : antecedente personas después de preposición	"This is the boy <b>about whom</b> you were asking me"
<b>WHICH</b> : antecedente cosas, también después de preposición, no después de <i>everything, anything, all, etc.</i>	"That is the file <b>with which</b> he was working"
<b>THAT</b> : antecedente personas y cosas, no entre comas	"Everything ( <b>that</b> ) I do I do it for you"
<b>WHAT</b> : sin antecedente	"He didn't do <b>what</b> I told him"
<b>WHOSE</b> : indica posesión, seguido de lo que el sujeto posee	"The car <b>whose door</b> didn't work was fixed"
ADVERBIOS RELATIVOS	
<b>WHERE</b> : antecedente lugar(en el cual, donde)	"The house <b>where</b> I was born was sold last year"
<b>WHEN</b> : antecedente momento(en el cual, cuando)	"I can't remember the time <b>when</b> I met you"
<b>WHY</b> : antecedente idea o razón(por la/el cual)	"The reason <b>why</b> he is so sad is a mystery to us"
