The most unique hotels in the world

After you have been travelling a while, every hotel begins to look the same. For those who have got bored of standard hotels, here are some of the most unique hotels in the world.

The first one is a tree hotel in Sweden. It consists of seven living capsules suspended in tall pines up to 20 feet above the forest floor, getting into them via ladder, suspended bridge or electric stairs. From September to March, the hotel's employees give guided northern lights tours and all year long, you can eat at the on-site restaurant, which specializes in northern Swedish cuisine.

The second choice is an igloo hotel in Finland. It is located 150 miles north of the Arctic Circle. Its rows of glass-domed igloos allow the guests an unobstructed view of aurora borealis. Inside each igloo you will find sleeping bags to keep toasty in the room's below-freezing temperature.

Another option is a train hotel in Pennsylvania. It is a weird hotel that is surrounded by Amish farms, with an on-site dining car. The sleeping quarters resemble basic motel rooms, except that they are set in real wagons.

Finally, a salt hotel in Bolivia. It is built entirely of salt. Its walls, ceilings and sculptures, as well as the majority of its furniture, including the beds, are made from large salt bricks. The property, which sits at an elevation of 12,000 feet, also offers a full-service spa and a fine-dining restaurant.
