**65 YEARS ON THE THRONE**

On the 6<sup>th</sup> February 2017, Elizabeth II became the first British monarch to reach a Blue Sapphire Jubilee, 65 years to the day since she ascended the throne.

The country celebrated this anniversary by creating a new five-pound coin. It will contain the words the queen said nearly 70 years ago, the day she turned 21: "My whole life, whether it be long or short, shall be devoted to your service"

She became the Queen of England in 1952 after her father George VI, who was suffering from lung cancer, died unexpectedly, in his sleep at Sandringham. At the time, a 25-year-old Princess Elizabeth was thousands of miles away in Kenya with her husband.

But this is not the first record she breaks: The Queen became Britain's longest reigning monarch in September 2015, after 63 years and 216 days on the throne, breaking the record set by her great-great-grandmother, Queen Victoria.

Decades of duty have defined the queen. She has traveled more than a million miles, visited about 120 countries and 12 US presidents, from Dwight D. Eisenhower to Barack Obama. And at the age of 90, she continues to perform her royal duties, carrying out 80 public engagements in 2016.

After so many years on the throne — longer than most Britons have been alive — many people have come to respect her quiet devotion to duty and her determination to keep her private life out of sight.
